How much of my sponsorship is tax deductible?

72% of the cost of your ticket/sponsorship is tax deductible. That works out to:

Item	Cost	Charitable Donation
Ticket	\$65	\$ 46.80
Bronze	\$650	\$ 468.00
Silver	\$1,500	\$1,080.00
Gold	\$3,500	\$2,520.00
Platinum	\$5,000	\$3,600.00

Is it okay to bring in our own food and drink to the party?

While Big Brothers Big Sisters provides dinner and free access to beer and soft drinks, many sponsors wish to bring in extra food and drinks to add a unique quality to their tent/table. BBBS does not prohibit sponsors from this activity; however, we will take no responsibility for serving food or drinks other than that provided by the event.

Can we add decorations to our tent?

Tent sponsors are welcome to custom decorate their tents, BBBS only asks that all sponsors understand and follow these basic rules:

- Decorations cannot extend beyond physical boundaries defined by your tent poles and ropes.
- No open flame or items requiring electricity may be used in decorations.
- BBBS is not responsible for theft of or damage to decorations before, during or after the event

When can I begin to decorate my tent and bring in extra food/drink on Saturday?

Sponsors are welcome to participate in decorating their tents and bring in food/drink any time on Saturday from 10:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. All decorations must be in place by 4:30 P.M. and any vehicles that do not have a preferred parking pass must be removed. Sponsors may bring extra food as they come to the party, but will not be allowed to drive beyond the main gate without a preferred parking pass. All vehicles must be out of the tent area by 4:30 P.M. unless you have a VIP Parking Pass.

What if somebody at my tent/table has had too much to drink?

BBBS works with C&H Taxi Service to insure that all of our party participants make it home safe. If anyone needs a ride home, please contact the BBBS tent and we will provide a taxi voucher to them.

Where do I park?

We will be providing volunteers to assist you in parking. General parking is beyond the main gate and will be plainly visible. There will be trolley service available from 5:00 P.M. to Midnight to assist people in getting back and forth from their cars.

Each tent sponsor also receives a number of Preferred Parking Passes based on the level of sponsorship.

The flyers say No one under 21 is admitted. Does this include small children and babies?

Yes, this rule is absolute and applies to all persons under age 21. Anyone suspected of being underage will be asked to present identification. If they are unwilling or unable to present valid identification, they will be made to leave the party. Also, any adult who brings children or babies will be asked to remove the children from the premises immediately.
